## **EDITORIAL**

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2020, all issues of Volume 10 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

Journal of Natural Product and Plant Resources during this year released 3 issues jumping from the frequency of 2 in the previous years.

The Journal of Natural Product and Plant Resources has its article indexed and archived in Google Scholar.

During the calendar year 2020, JNPPR received a total of 24 papers, out of which articles (30%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2020 around 17 articles were subjected for publication after they were accepted in the peer review process. In the 3 issues of Volume 10 published during the year 2020, a total of 17 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors belonging mostly to the high income countries. A total of 60 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 17 articles published in volume 10. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2020, a total of 10 Editors, 40 Reviewers joined the board of JNPPR and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Prof. Vincenzo De Feo during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Francisco Torrens in bringing out issues of JNPPR in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of JNPPR, the office bearers for their support in bringing out yet another volume of JNPPR and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 11 of JNPPR in scheduled time.
